# SURVEY LIMITATIONS

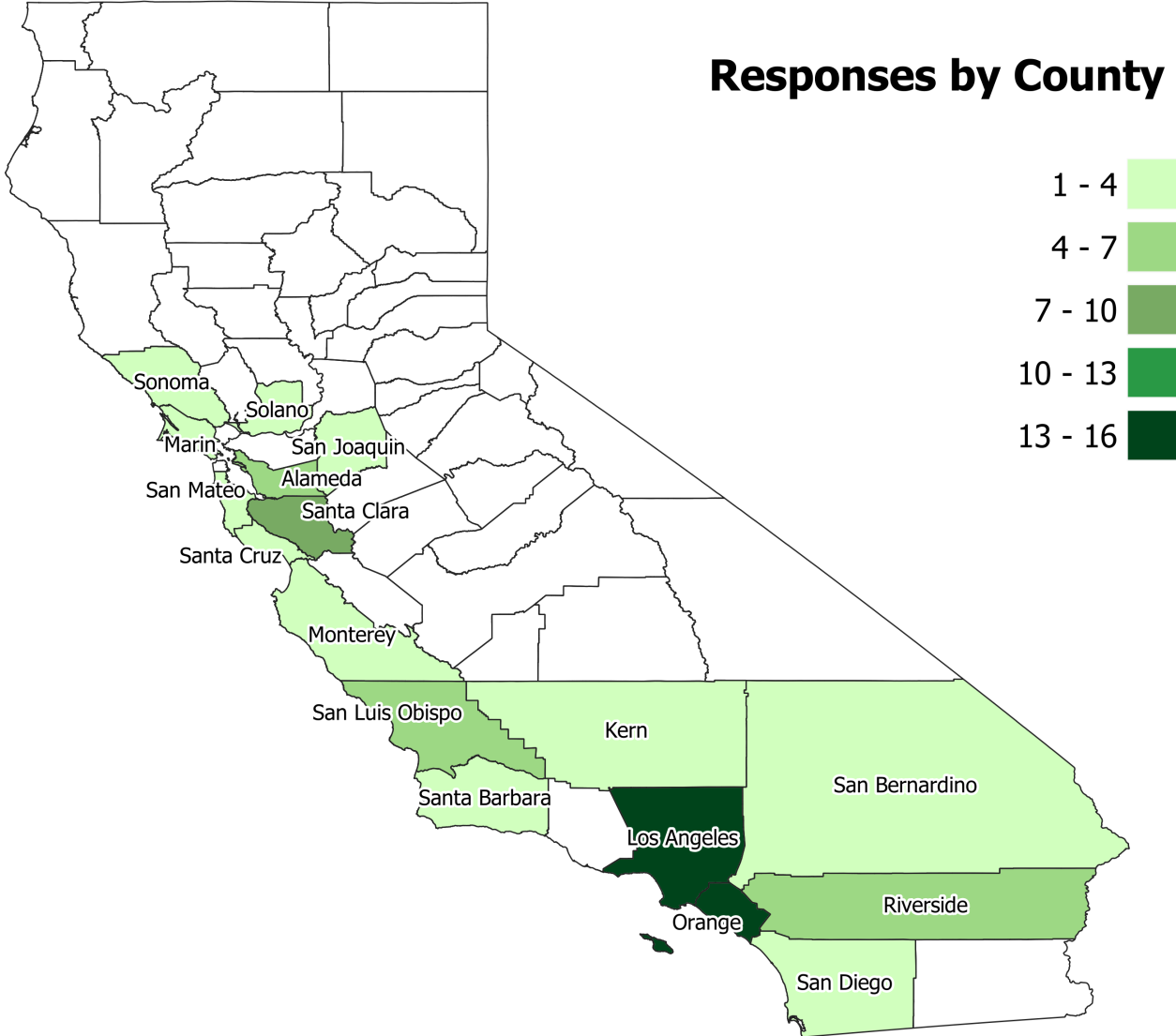
- Voluntary online survey

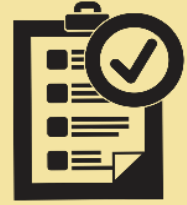

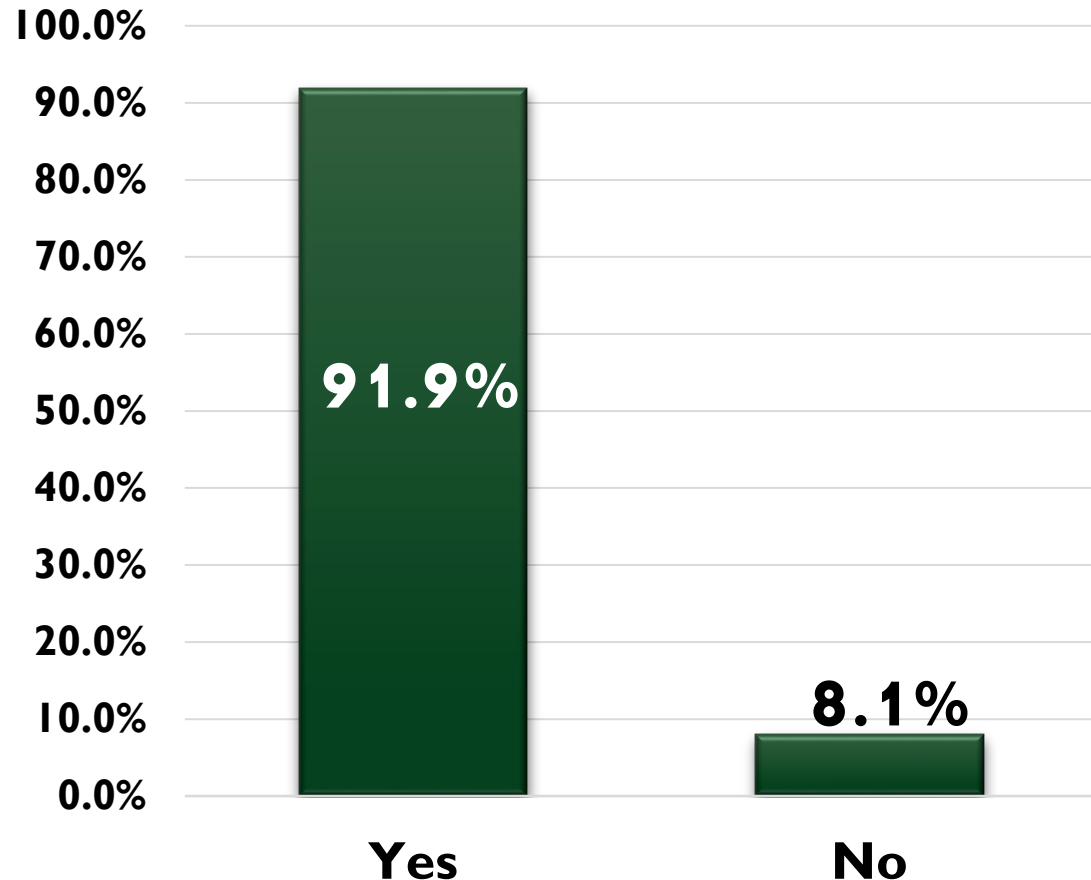
# STATE MAP OF PARTICIPATING JURISDICTION



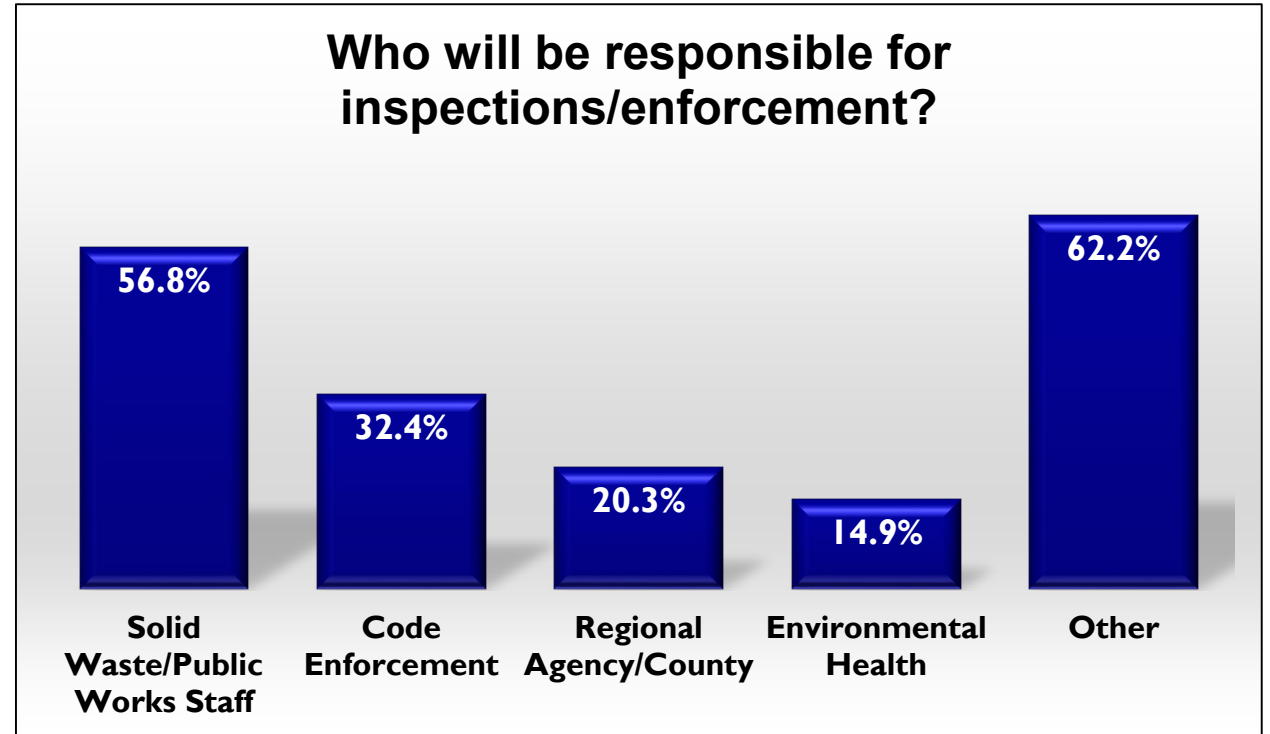
# ORDINANCES AND ENFORCEABLE MECHANISMS



Has your agency adopted SB 1383 ordinances/enforceable mechanisms?

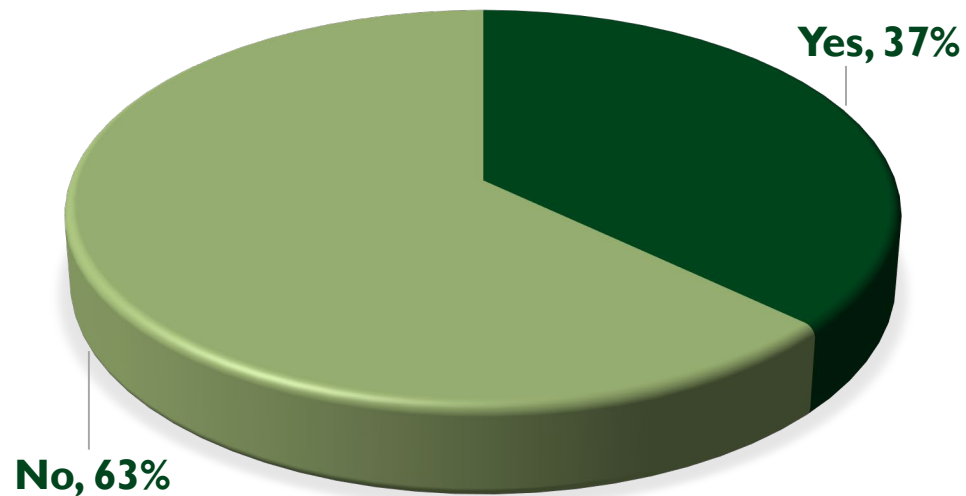


Who will be responsible for inspections/enforcement?

Has your agency approved new franchise agreement(s) or franchise amendment(s) to delegate SB 1383 responsibilities?

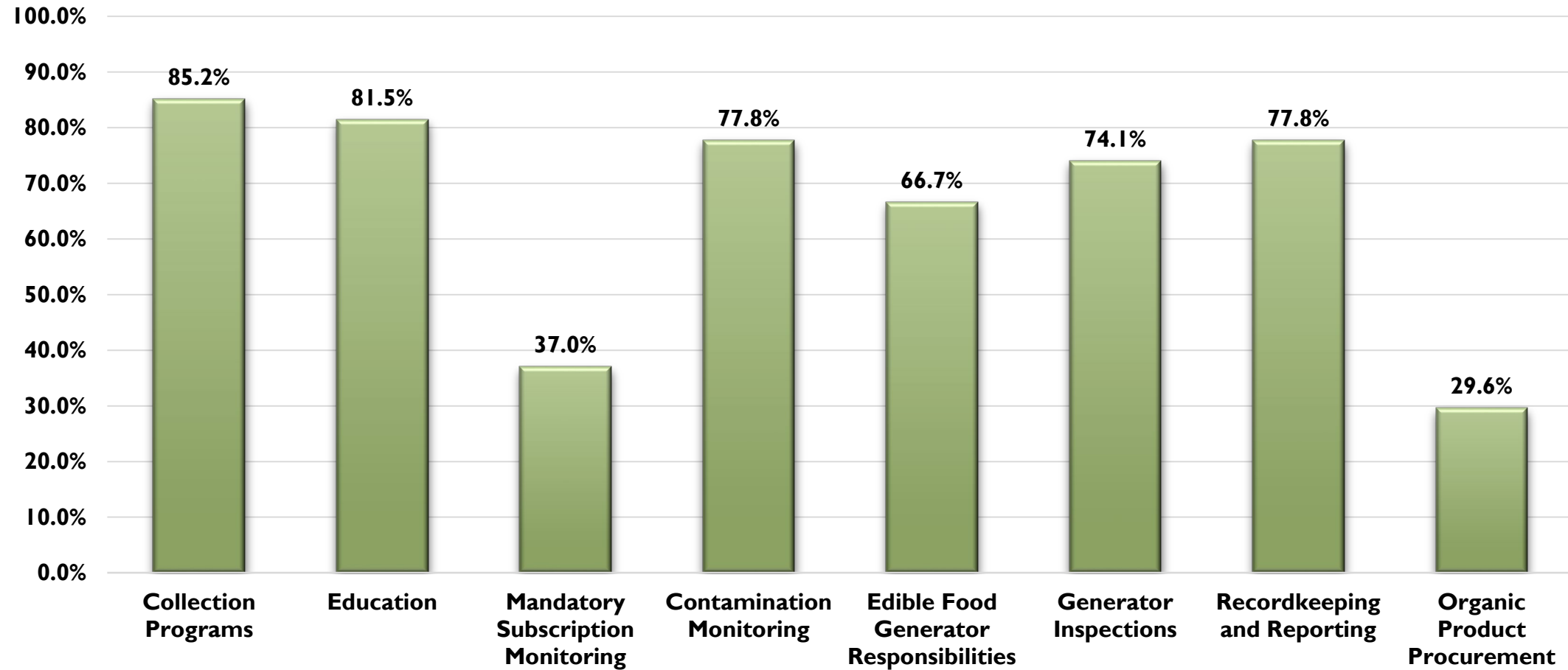

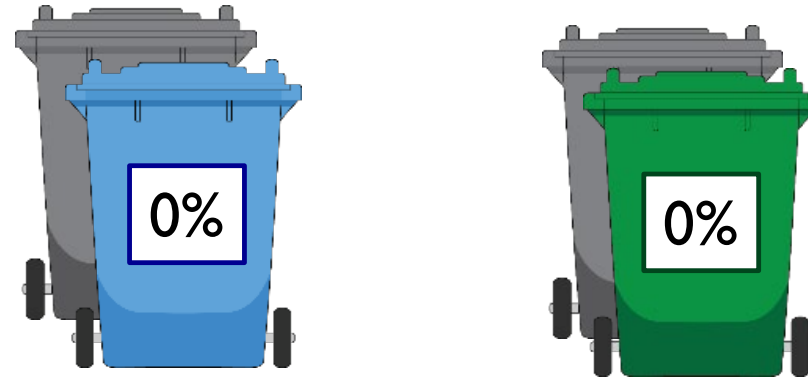
What responsibilities have been (or will be) delegated to contractor(s)?

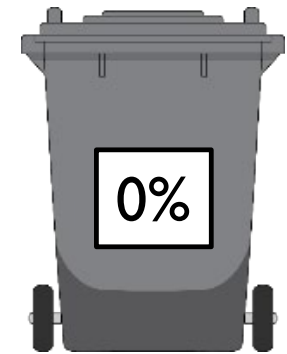

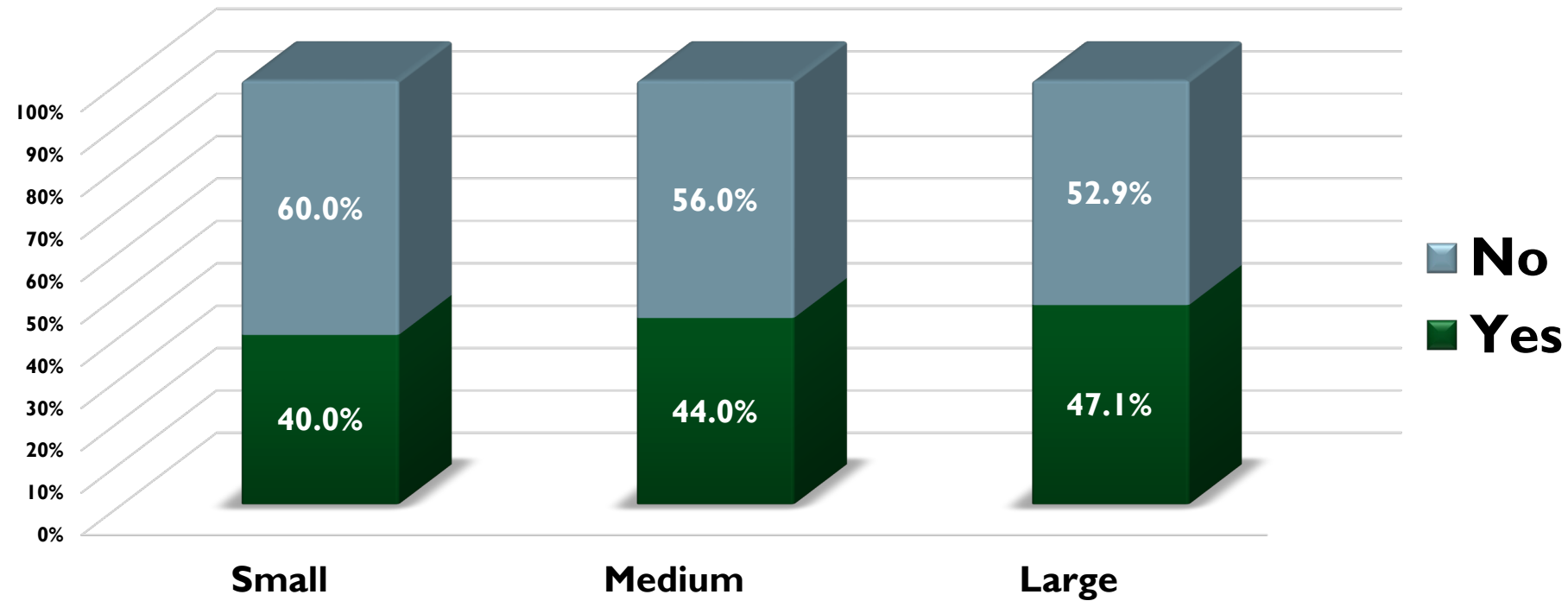

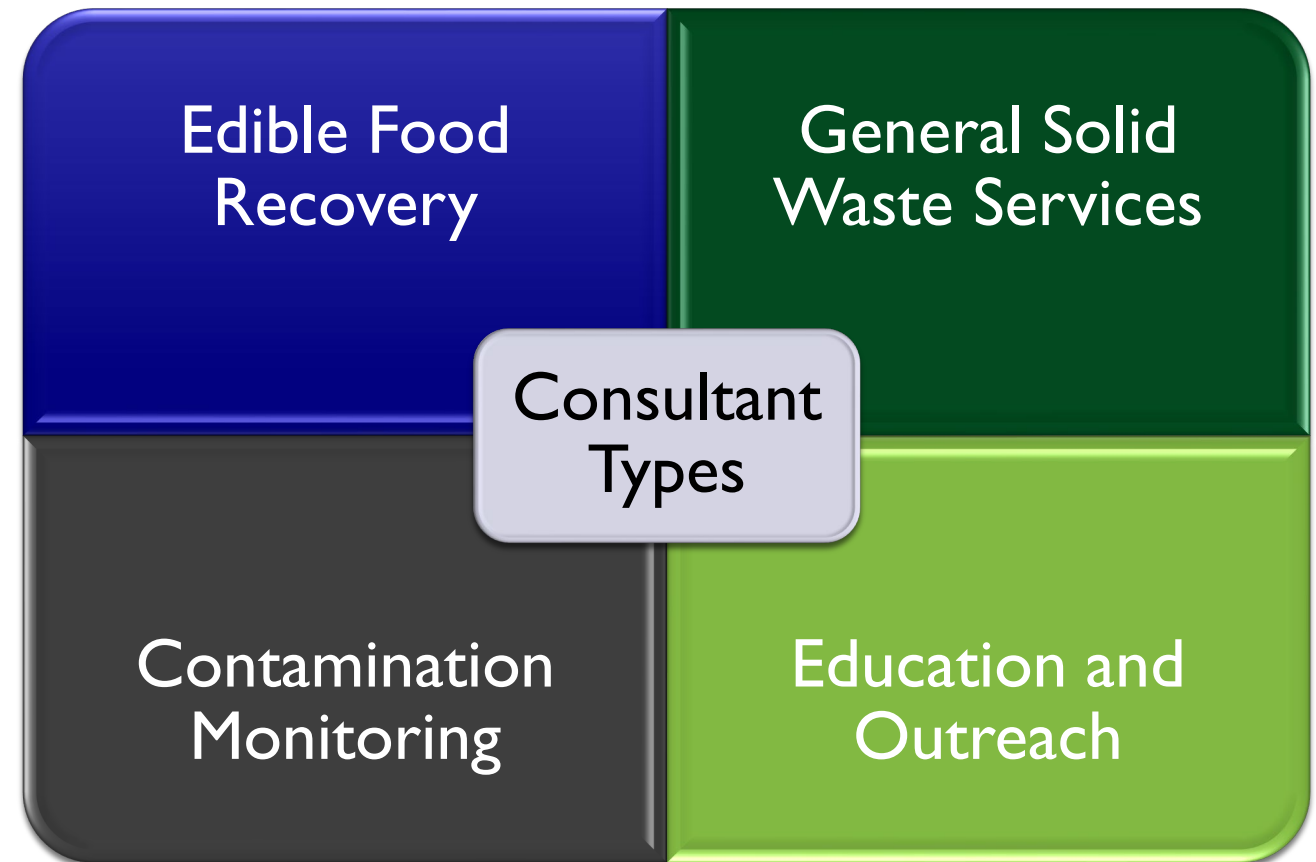
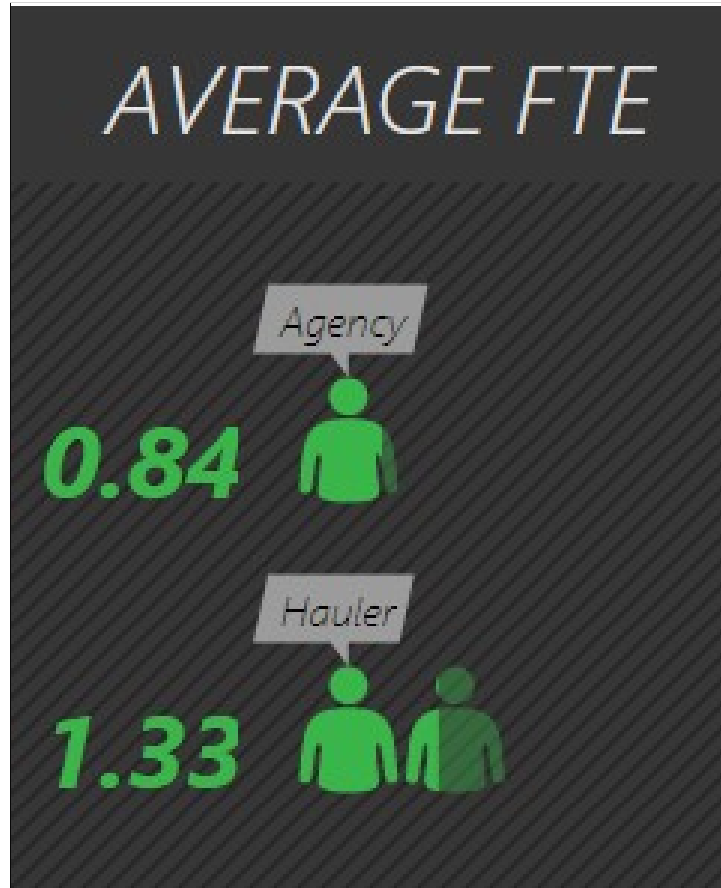
# REPORTING POLICIES AND PROCEDURES



Has your agency established internal policies/procedures for reporting?

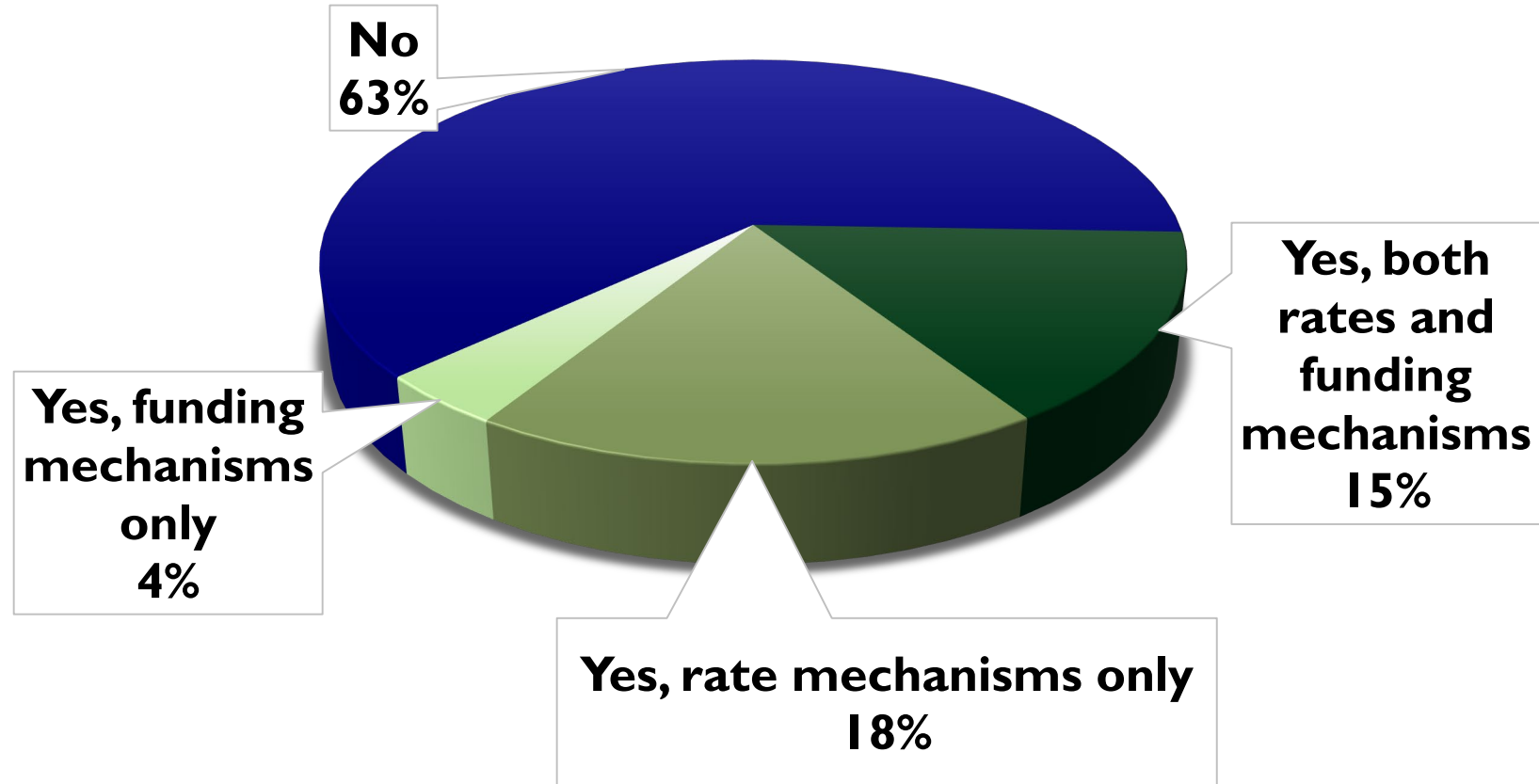

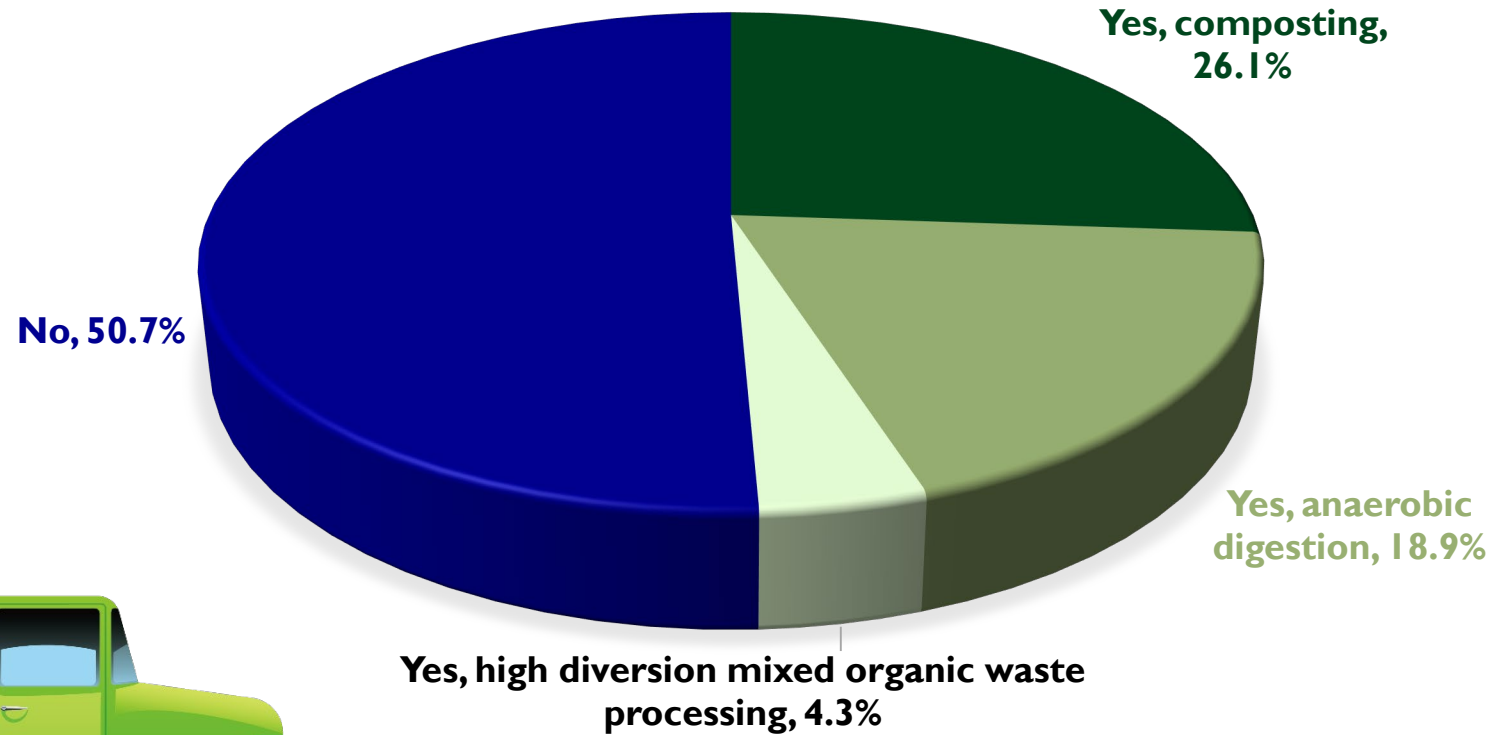

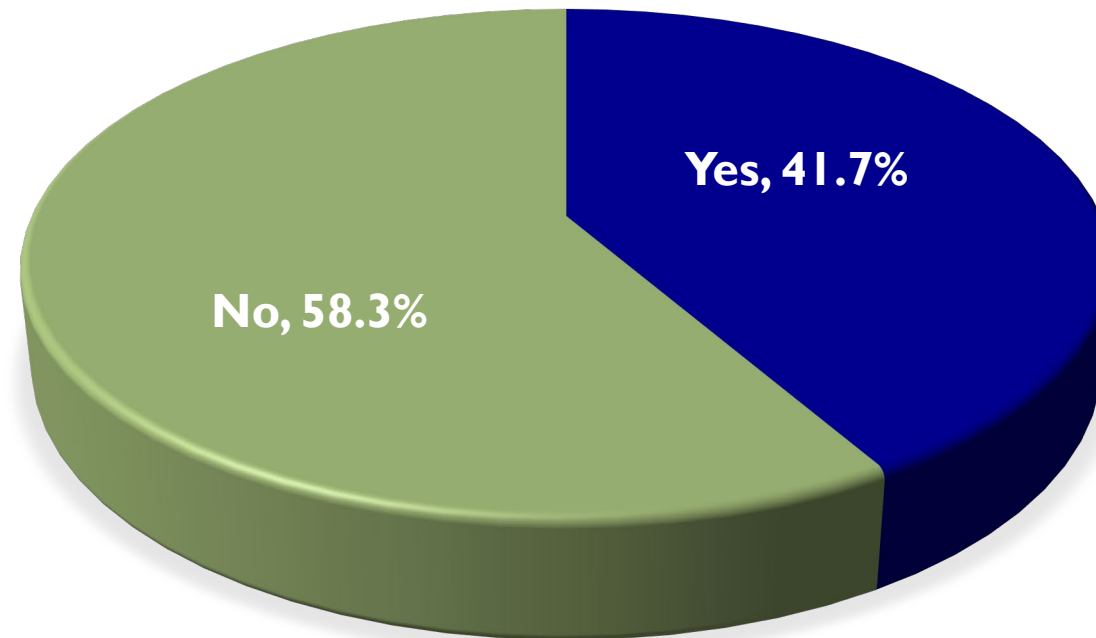
Does your agency own or contract for infrastructure to process organic material collected in your jurisdiction?

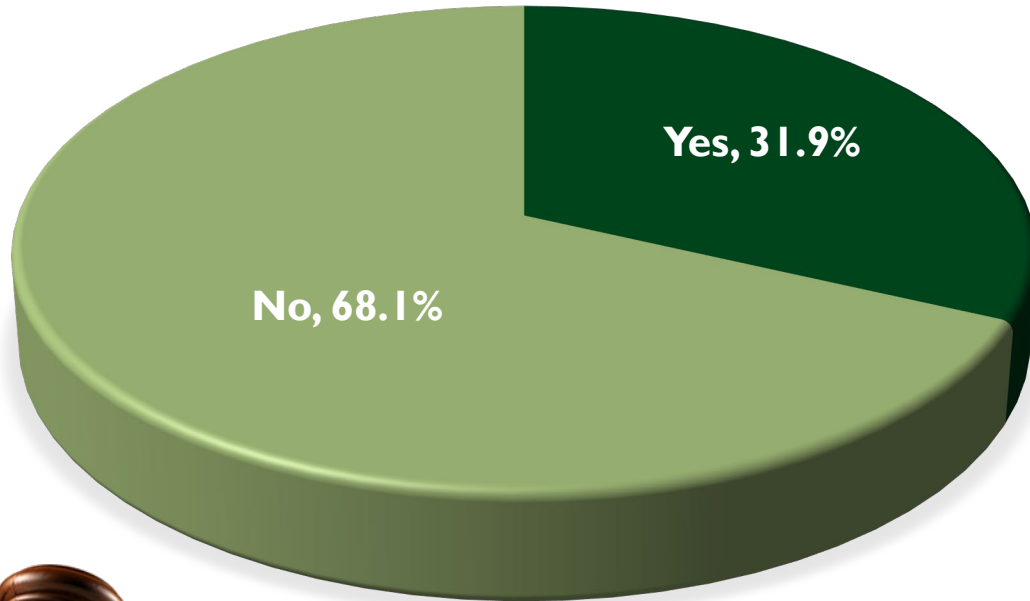
Has your agency established internal policies/procedures for recovered organic waste procurement?



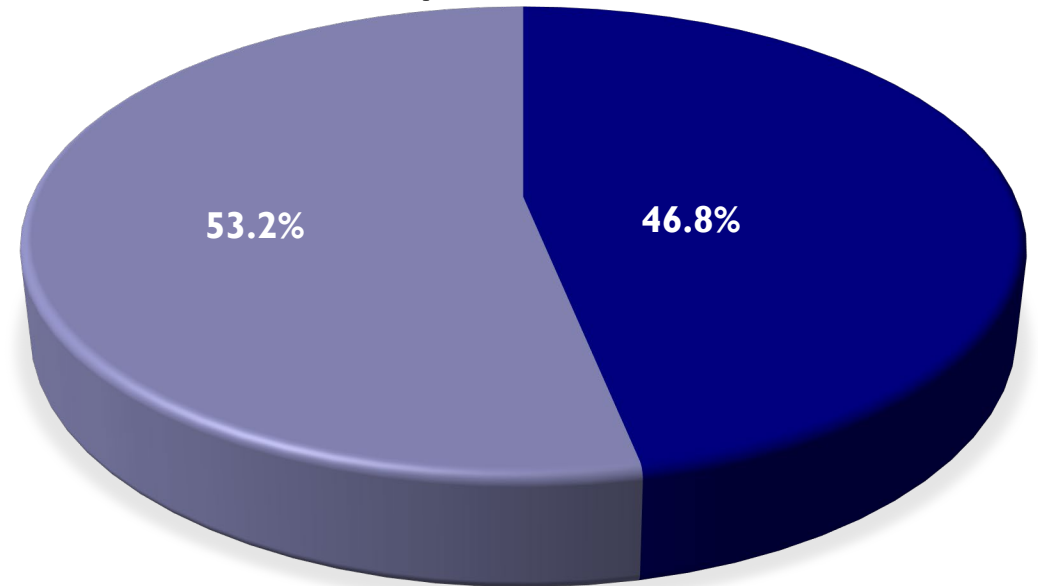

# UNIQUE OR INNOVATIVE PLANS ON THE HORIZON?

- SB 1383 Local Assistance Grant funding

- Phase-in of mandatory container roll-outs for recycling and organics
- Camera based route reviews
- Equity in multi-family services
- Challenging housing types
- Software tool development

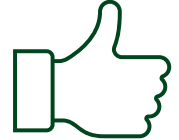

# SUMMARY



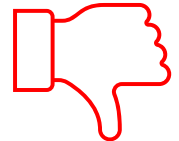
**92% of agencies have adopted an ordinance or enforceable mechanism**



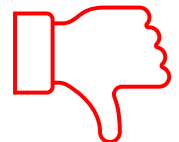
**0% of agencies plan to/have implemented 1 or 2 container system**



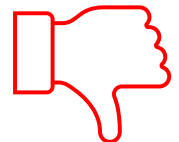
**55% of agencies have not established reporting procedures**



**58% of agencies do not have internal policies or procedures for recovered organic waste product procurement**



**68% of agencies did not submit a NOIC, of those, 47% do not have a franchise agreement or amendment adopted**
